On Monday, October 16th is World Food Day, a day designated by the United Nations to think about global food issues. In Japan, about 5.23 million tons of foods that can still be eaten are being thrown away each year.

October is 3R (reduce, reuse, recycle) promotion month

Let's try to reduce waste through the 3Rs for the realization of a recycling-oriented society, including effective use of resources and reduction of environmental burdens.

- **Reduce** Use things carefully and reduce waste.
- Reuse Buy long-lasting products and use them repeatedly.
- Recycle Reuse garbage as a resource.

Tama City is promoting the 4Rs by adding "Refuse" to the 3Rs. Refuse: Avoid producing waste.

- **Application:** By post or internet = Must be postmarked by Oct. 18 (Wed.) \sim Nov. 8 (Wed.) At the counter = Oct. 30 (Mon.) \sim Nov. 8 (Wed.) 9am \sim 5pm (In principle, please use mail or internet procedures)
- Eligible facilities: Licensed daycare center, certified nursery school, home-based daycare center, small-scale daycare center, in-house daycare center
- NOTE: Applications for certified daycare centers are accepted at any time at the facilities.
 Briefing sessions for admission to child daycare centers, etc., are scheduled to be held at each local parenting support center. For details, please contact each center.
