● REVISION OF NATIONAL PENSION INSURANCE PREMIUM AND PROCEDURES UPON RETIREMENT

The national pension insurance premium for fiscal year 2025 has been revised to 17,510 yen per month. Those affected by this change must complete the necessary procedures.

- ♦ Target: ①Residents of Japan aged 20 to 60 years old at the time they lose eligibility for Employee's Pension Insurance (excluding those who enroll in the Employees' Pension Insurance at their new workplace the day after resigning).
 - ②Husbands and wives aged 20 to 60 who are financially supported by a retired spouse or a spouse aged 65 and enrolled in the Employees' Pension Insurance.
- ♦Things to bring: Documents showing the date of retirement (certificate of loss of eligibility for employee's pension or social insurance, etc.), basic pension number or individual number, identity documents (IDs) such as driver's license.
- ♦Note: An exemption scheme is available for those who have difficulty paying their national pension premiums due to low income or other reasons (application is required)
