● DO YOU THINK IT'S JUST A SIMPLE ARGUMENT? ~Parental fights can hurt a child's mind~

Research shows that when children experience extreme stress, their brains may actually shrink or change shape as they try to adapt. However, with early care and attention, they can recover – so it's important to notice and respond as soon as possible.

*Even if a child isn't in the same room, they can still feel anxious or scared by the sounds and tension of an argument.

*Parents may not intend to cause harm, but children can easily find their parents' behavior frightening.

*Frequent arguments between parents can sometimes become a form of psychological abuse for the child. \(\triangle \triangle

Evacuation procedures for those who cannot stay at home or evacuate to relatives (for example, due to damage to their residence or nearby fires)

⇒First, evacuate to primary evacuation shelters (elementary and junior high schools, gymnasiums, etc.)

- •Those who require assistance will be evacuated to the "Welfare Space" within the primary evacuation shelter.
