●NO APPLICATIONS REQUIRED FOR HIGH-COST MEDICAL EXPENSE BENEFIT UNDER THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE AND MEDICAL CARE INSURANCE FOR THE ELDERLY PERSONS

If your out-of-pocket medical expenses in one month exceed the maximum limit, you can apply to receive the amount over the limit as a "high-cost medical expense benefit." If you are eligible: National Health Insurance enrollees will receive an application form from the City Hall Insurance and Pension Section about three months after the month of treatment; Medical Care Insurance for the Elderly Persons (Latter-stage) enrollees will receive an application form from the Tokyo Metropolitan Association of Medical Care for the Elderly Persons at least four months after the month of treatment. Please note that the monthly out-of-pocket limit will change for medical care received on or after August 2026.
