THE 2023 TAMA CITY COMPREHENSIVE DISASTER PREVENTION DRILL WILL BE HELD

On Saturday, September 2nd, a drill based on the assumption of an earthquake directly under the eastern Tama will be conducted. This year, safety confirmation drills will be held in the Suwa, Renkoji, Hijirigaoka and Nagayama districts using Tama City designated garbage bags with "We are safe" message printed on them, and the training for setting up and management of evacuation centers in elementary and junior high schools in each district.

At 4 p.m., a siren sound from the disaster administrative radio system will be heard. In addition, pet spaces will also be open to the public at three evacuation centers in the Suwa district. You can actually bring your pets with you. Please bring them in a cage.

Time 4 p.m. ~7 p.m. (Will be held rain or shine, cancelled in case of stormy weather) Note A training on setting up and management of evacuation shelters will be held at Suwa Jr. High School, Suwa Elem. School, Kita-Suwa Elem. School, Renkoji Elem. School, Hijirigaoka Jr. High School, Hijirigaoka Elem. School, Tama Nagayama Jr. High School, Nagayama Elem. School, and Uryu Elem. School. (You can come to observe by 5 p.m. ~6:30 p.m. You need to bring your indoor shoes.) Application Come to the place directly on the day. THE ROAD RACE TOKYO TAMA 2023 will be held using the course of the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Cycling Road Race, where athletes including top Japanese athletes will compete.

Date/Time Sunday, December 3rd for around 4 hours (plan) Place Along the road racing course in Tama City Eligible Applicants must be 16 yrs. of age or older at the time of application (Jr. high school graduate or above; if you are below 18 at the time of application, you will need to submit a letter of consent from a person with parental authority, etc.) Contents of activity Organizing and guiding spectators and pedestrians along the course to secure the route, and preventing them from entering the course, etc. Note Attendance at a pre-briefing in early November is required. ● CHANGING THE LAYOUT OF THE CITY HALL TO CREATE A SAFE AND COMFORTABLE SPACE FOR VISITORS

From Monday, August 14th onward, the layout of the first, second, and fourth floors of the main city hall building and the second floor of *daini chosha* (city hall annex) will be subsequently changed to provide more space for the counters and corridors, which had not been sufficiently spacious until now. By securing enough space around the counter, the environment will be more privacy-friendly for those who come to consult with us. Also, by widening the width of the corridor the waiting area can be secured and anyone can pass through without worry.

- ■From Monday, August 14th, the Economy and Tourism Section on the 2nd floor of the main building, and the Community and Life Section, Culture and Lifelong Learning Promotion Section, and Sports Promotion Section on the 4th floor will move to the 2nd floor of *daini chosha*. The Welfare and General Affairs Section will move from 4th floor to the 2nd floor of the main building.
- ■From Tuesday, October 10th, the Childcare Support Section and the Children and Youth Section will move from the 2nd floor to the 4th floor of the main building. A consultation space on the 4th floor will be set up! By creating a consultation space away from the counter provides privacy and can seek advice without worry.

■From November onward, the Welfare and General Affairs Section on the 2nd floor of the main building and the Office for Promotion of Health/Wellbeing and Community Development on the 1st floor will move to the 2nd floor of the main building.

Widening of the corridors on the first and second floors of the main building! By moving the counters back, the corridors around the counters will be widened, making it easier to pass through for people in wheelchairs and those with disabilities, and will provide more privacy for those seeking advice.


